

Premier Night – Friday, August 20, 2009

What: Potluck dinner beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the cafeteria and in the Mustang Center. Doors will be open at the main entrance to the school and on the north side of the building by the band room. The potluck tables will be in the cafeteria.

What to bring:

Every family should bring a main dish (casseroles, fried chicken, pizza, tacos, enchiladas etc.).

A-N should also bring a salad (fruit, vegetable, pasta etc.)

O-Z should bring a dessert cut into single serving sizes.

Serving utensils, table service and drinks will be provided.

Students and what they should wear: All band students will eat first so they can prepare for their exhibition at 7:30. They should wear pep band shirt, BLUE jean shorts, black Drillmaster shoes and black golf ankle socks. (If your student's pep band shirt is not here yet, they need to wear a royal blue shirt). Note: This is a required performance of all band students, freshmen through seniors.

Order of Events: We will eat from 6-7 p.m. A parent information meeting will be held at 7 p.m. in the auditorium. You will learn about the Band Boosters and what we do. At 7:30 we will all go out to the soccer field (North of the tennis courts) to watch an exhibition by the band students. You will get to see what a "drill down" is.

This is a must event for all freshman parents! We ask that at least one freshman parent come to Premier Night so you can find out what happens in band, not only for your child but also for parents. Being a freshman band parent can seem overwhelming and confusing. Come get your questions answered.

Booster Buttons:
